Come on out and see what all the excitement has been about at the next M&G on Tuesday, September 22nd @ 7:30 pm.



SAFETY TIP OF THE WEEK

Low Speed Riding!

This is used in city traffic, moving off from a stop, turning around in parking lots, turning around on a road/highway to change direction.

What to do and how to practise it:

- The technique of riding your motorcycle clutch at the friction zone- the area when the clutch is released begins the engaging of the power to the rear wheel.
- Rear brake is applied creating a drag and increasing stability of the motorcycle
- No front brake use
- Throttle at constant level creating available power.
- Clutch controls delivery of power to rear wheel need more: clutch out; need less: clutch slightly in.
- Upper body relaxed don't fight handlebars/steering.



FAVORITE ROADS

Route 66 The Mother of all rides on America's Mother Road. Covering 8 US

States and over 2,700 miles this ride will take you through some incredible scenery along what once used to be the heart and soul of the United States.

Before the Super Slab Interstates were built, this was THE HUB of America and the main road to travel. Now there are many historic sites and dosed gas stations, restaurants and movie theatres to remind you of how life used to be. There will be a stop in Coboconk for coffee and fuel for the smaller tanks.


Reservations for lunch are for 12:00 pm


After lunch we will stop at the General store and then to the Lookout Tower before riding back home. We will be back approximately 6:00 pm ish.
