## SAFETY TIP OF THE WEEK

**R**aise your Gaze

Many people watch the road immediately in front of them. While you should be aware of what's directly in your path, **you will be more aware if you RAISE YOUR GAZE.** You should be scanning the road to see what is approximately **5 seconds in front of you and 10 seconds in front of you.** This will prepare you for things like cars turning, objects on the road, and pedestrians or animals that may cross in to your path. This is even more important on long sweeping corners to help you see what is coming around the bend. **Remember your eyes will go where you are looking.**

**Niagara Parkway** This road is not very long but it makes up for it in scenery. You will pass right over the Generating Station as you wind along the river with the good old US of A in sight close enough to skip a rock from one country to the other. There is a ride being planned to go to Sauble Beach with a 2 night stay at Sauble Beach Lodge ([www.saublebeachlodge.com](http://www.saublebeachlodge.com))

For those who attended our trip last year, it was a great weekend of fun and laughs. There were a few of our members that elected to go on Friday night and stay for two nights, and many others that suggested they would like to do the two nights this year. **So we are planning for the two nights. A one night option is available at a different rate.**

This motel has various accommodations available to suit our needs. They have motel rooms as well as cottage type rooms that are pet friendly/cabins only. They have a heated outdoor pool that they will make sure remains open for our stay. They have a pool table, fire pits and BBQ's that are at our disposal. One of the most appealing attributes is that it is only a few minutes' walk from the beach.

There are lots to see and do, relax or just hang out, whatever you choose. The stores in the core are open and offer various shopping. There is a local restaurant/bar within walking distance that generally offers entertainment on Saturday nights. There is a liquor and beer store in town along with a grocery store if you want to pick anything up. Last year we collected money from each person (approx. \$15.00) and hosted a BBQ Saturday night and breakfast Sunday morning, along with snacks and water. It made it a very affordable weekend for us all. The guys did a great job preparing breakfast!!!



**A special price has been negotiated, giving us a rate of \$189.00 plus tax for 2 nights for a family suite or cabin. If you would like just a standard room with two double beds the rate is 150.00 plus tax.**
