


FAVORITE ROADS

Hwy 35 from Norland to Dwight This road took some time to perfect. It's a little wider, the curves a little longer and the surface is smoooooooth. Although this stretch of road is only 95 kms long, it is threaded along a scenic corridor featuring some incredible lookouts, roadside attractions and of course good eats. A MUST stop is the Robinson General Store in Dorset and while in Dorset you might as well climb the 30 meter Lookout Tower. Built in 1967 to scout for forest fires, you can see 7 lakes from atop the tower on the mountain.

For those who attended our trip last year, it was a great weekend of fun and laughs. There were a few of our members that elected to go on Friday night and stay for two nights, and many others that suggested they would like to do the two nights this year. So we are planning for the two nights. A one night option is available at a different rate.

This motel has various accommodations available to suit our needs. They have motel rooms as well as cottage type rooms that are pet friendly/cabins only. They have a heated outdoor pool that they will make sure remains open for our stay.

They have a pool table, fire pits and BBQ's that are at our disposal. One of the most appealing attributes is that it is only a few minutes' walk from the beach.

There are lots to see and do, relax or just hang out, whatever you choose. The stores in the core are open and offer various shopping. There is a local restaurant/bar within walking distance that generally offers entertainment on Saturday nights. There is a liquor and beer store in town along with a grocery store if you want to pick anything up. Last year we collected money from each person (approx. \$15.00) and hosted a BBQ Saturday night and breakfast Sunday moming, along with snacks and water. It made it a very affordable weekend for us all. The guys did a great job preparing breakfast!!!



A special price has been negotiated, giving us a rate of \$189.00 plus tax for 2 nights for a family suite or cabin. If you would like just a standard room with two double beds the rate is 150.00 plus tax.

We hate to talk about the fall but unfortunately it will be sooner than we would like. This is not a busy weekend generally for Sauble Beach, but there is always a possibility for another group to do the same thing and book rooms. Please start booking your rooms now, to avoid disappointment.
