


#### \*\*\*Meet & Greet\*\*\*

#### **SAFETY TIP OF THE WEEK**

Don't follow too close behind the vehicle ahead of you. There are some really good reasons to stay well back from traffic. If the vehicle ahead of you has any type of load attached to it, such as someone carrying furniture or house contents, you may want to stay

back as the load might not be properly secured and the last thing you want to do is end up swerving hard or getting vaulted through the air from an object falling from the back. Also, you want to have enough time to swerve safely if there is anything such as road kill or tire strips from transports or pot holes lying in your lane.


Ride details will be posted on the forum and here in next week's newsletter but it <u>WILL BE AN ALL DAY RIDE</u>.
